The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Block Grant funds prevention, intervention, substance use disorder (SUD) treatment, and recovery support services.

Priority Population for Substance Use Disorder Treatment Requirements:

Individual are admitted to treatment in the following order: 1) Pregnant, Injecting Individuals; 2. Pregnant Individual; 3. Injecting Individual; 4. Individual referred by the Department of Family and Protective Services

Pregnant Individuals are admitted immediately!!!!

Outreach, Screening, Assessment and Referral (OSAR): While there is no “wrong door,” the OSAR programs serve as the “front door” to the HHSC-funded substance use disorder service system within each HHSC Region. OSARs provide confidential alcohol and drug screenings and assessments, referrals for SUD services and other community resources, education and support, and case management for individuals who need assistance in accessing services. All Texas residents seeking treatment for SUD are eligible for OSAR services.

Program Types:

Adult Residential Detoxification Services: This level of care provides a structured environment for clients who are physically dependent upon substances to safely withdraw from those substances, and for clients who are intoxicated to be medically monitored until achieving a non-intoxicated state.

Adult Ambulatory Detoxification Services: This level of care provides a safe withdrawal for clients who are physically dependent upon substances to receive outpatient counseling while receiving detoxification medication.

Intensive Residential Services: This level of care provides 24-hour per day, 7 days per week multidisciplinary, professional clinical support to begin treatment and recovery while receiving an average of 30 hours of service each week comprised of counseling, education, life skills and structured activities.

Supportive Residential Services: This level of care allows the client to reside in the community while receiving at least six hours of services each week consisting of counseling and education and support is offered to transition into community resources such as housing, education, employment as part of their recovery. ***Residential services available for youth**

Women and Children's Residential and Supportive Residential Services: This service type provides allows women to enter SUD treatment with their children while providing gender specific treatment for women and receive weekly parenting education, reproductive health education, and gender specific groups.

Adult - Methadone Treatment: This level of care is for individuals whom have been diagnosed with an Opioid Use Disorder (Moderate to Severe) to alleviate adverse physiological effects of withdrawal from the use of opiates and to detoxify the client to a drug-free state over a period of time that is required to meet the individualized needs of the client while receiving counseling and other recovery support services.

Outpatient Services: Outpatient programs are designed for clients who do not require the more structured environment of residential treatment to maintain sobriety. ***Outpatient services available for youth**

ASAM Dimensions

Dimension 1: Acute Intoxication and/or Withdrawal Potential

Dimension 2: Biomedical Conditions and Complications

Dimension 3: Emotional, Behavioral, or Cognitive Conditions and Complications

Dimension 4: Readiness to Change

Dimension 5: Relapse, Continued Use, or Continued Problem Potential

Dimension 6: Recovery /Living Environment
