ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINES

The 146th Judicial District Court having received the First Emergency Order Regarding The COVID-19 State of Disaster issued in Misc. Docket No. 20-007 from the Supreme Court of Texas on March 13, 2020 following the Governor's declaration of the State of Disaster, this Court hereby finds that all cases filed in this Court under the Texas Family Code should have the statutory deadlines extended for a period not to exceed 30 days following the date the Governor's State of Disaster has been lifted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all statutory deadlines and procedures for cases filed by or involving the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services are hereby extended for a period of 30 days following the date the Governor's State of Disaster has been lifted unless any deadline is extended for a longer period of time in accordance with the Texas Family Code.

This order shall expire on the 31st day following the date the Governor's State of Disaster has been lifted.
